The ACTRESS who's playing Lt. Disher enters. That's right-Disher is played by a GORGEOUS, 30-ISH WOMAN. <u>actress</u>.

ACTRESS PLAYING DISHER

Yes, Captain?

Off stage: the real Stottlemeyer and Disher react, stunned.

ACTOR PLAYING STOTTLEMEYER

The victim just received a check for 50 thousand dollars- pretty weird time to kill yourself. What do you think?

Apparently, in the movie, there's <u>sexual tension</u> between Disher and Stottlemeyer! "Disher" moves closer to "Stottlemeyer"...

> ACTRESS PLAYING DISHER I'll tell you what I think. I think the department doesn't appreciate you enough.
