LT. Dishar steps up with two men: TOM BENNETT, the prison's angry, grim-faced warden... and DANIEL KRASNER, a prison guard. Krasner is fit, a little intense, mid 30's.

START →

LT. DISHER

Capt. Stottlemeyer. Adrian Monk. This is Tom Bennett. He's the warden here.

WARDEN BENNETT

Whatever you need, Captain. Whatever we can do.

CAPT. STOTTLEMEYER

We appreciate that. We're going to coordinate with the Sheriff's office, put together a task force. We'll get him.

Monk gulps. He glances, anxiously, over at Jack Junior.

WARDEN BENNETT

I can't wait to get that sonofabitch back here. This is personal. Everybody loved that woman- not just the inmates. The staff, too.

Lindsey worked late a lot. Sometimes
she was here all night. You know,
dedicated.

MONK
Did you actually see him, the escapee-
whose name, of course, is Joe Endicott-
attack Miss Bishop?

DANIEL KRASNER
No, sir. I can't say I did. I
thought I heard something, someone
screaming. I hit the lights. He
was right there, right by the car.
I got off three or four shots, but
he was gone.

Disher is holding an EVIDENCE BAG, with a SPOON inside. Its
handle has been sharpened. It's covered with blood.

MONK
Is that the weapon? A spoon?
